Hedron Hackerspace is an inclusive do-ocracy dedicated to fostering creative development and growth! Members are encouraged to make the space their own and contribute however they feel fits.

Respect the other shops

We are close neighbors with many other creative spaces in the building that have their own needs to attend to. Our neighbors are very friendly and helpful, but if you have questions, you're encouraged to ask someone from h.h first.

We all work to keep this space healthy and enjoyable

It's important that people feel comfortable, and that workspaces and tools are kept clean and usable. Everyone must pitch in on this for the space to support itself. If a member shows a pattern of failing to do this work, we might look into revoking their membership.

What do you get with your membership?

- Access to the space any time a facilitator is at the shop, and a class isn't in the way
- Access to tools, 3D printers, laser cutters, welders, art supplies, kitchenette, etc
- Discounted classes
- Access to the wealth of knowledge of your fellow shopmates. This is a very dynamic and communally empowering environment, with lots of talented people from different backgrounds
- 1hr of 1-on-1 equipment training per month
- A say in how the space is run. We'll host open meetings on many Wednesdays. Check the calendar! h.h aims to be a non-hierarchical do-ocracy, where its members put forth their energy into the community autonomously

How much does membership cost?

- \$40-\$80/month pay-what-you-are able scale. Price list here: <https://bit.ly/2Xv709Q>
Your monthly dues are decided with a facilitator upon signing up. Please let us know if your situation changes. There may be volunteer opportunities in exchange.
- Once you're a member in good standing for at least a month, you may get the door code if you've shown the ability to safely and responsibly use the space.
- Tool training beyond your free 1hr per month will be \$15/hr or negotiated with a facilitator
- Welders and laser cutters have an hourly to cover consumable costs

Code of Conduct

- See COVID Practices Agreement
- Participate in an authentic and active way. In doing so, you contribute to the health and longevity of this community
- Be inclusive, friendly, inviting, and helpful to those around you
- Do not use tools you are not yet authorized to use (laser cutter, welders, etc.) and respect any other honor systems. If you aren't sure of something, **please ask!**
- Respect shared spaces and keep them clean and usable for everyone, especially when you leave for the day
- When you see others abusing the space, we encourage you to speak with those people or someone else at the space
- If you damage equipment, you're responsible for paying for repairs if needed

List of Unacceptable Behaviour

- Violence, threats of violence or violent language
- Sexist, racist, homophobic, transphobic, ableist or otherwise discriminatory jokes and language
- Using tools or your body in an unsafe way that may hurt others or cause damage
- Personal insults, particularly those related to gender, sexual orientation, race, religion, or disability
- Inappropriate photography or recording
- Inappropriate physical contact. You should have someone's consent before touching them
- Unwelcome attention. This includes intentionally making people feel uncomfortable, sexualized comments or jokes, inappropriate touching, groping, and unwelcome sexual advances
- Sustained disruption of community events
- Using tools you are not allowed to, especially tools from other shops in the warehouse
- Using the space as a living space, large scale, or commercially in a way that interferes with others' ability to use the space fairly
- Taking things from the space without checking with a facilitator and logging it
